*Centennial Community Food Shelf is an emergency food shelf serving residents of Lexington, Circle Pines, Lino Lakes, Eastern Blaine and Centerville. Neighbors may come once a month and receive 3-5 days' supply of food. Two forms of identification are required, including proof that you live in the CCFS service area (bring a picture ID and a utility bill). No one is turned away without food.*

*CCFS operates through a partnership of local churches. Each church is asked to provide: 1) volunteers for the CCFS Board which administers operations, 2) trained crews to stock shelves and serve clients on service days assigned to their church, 3) volunteers to carry out other needed tasks, and 4) other kinds of support. Over 100 volunteers from affiliated partner churches help out at the food shelf each year.*

*Our Savior's Lutheran Church sponsors this all volunteer, ecumenical, community*

*food shelf. Therefore, CCFS has almost no operation or administration expenses. Our Savior's shares its space, utilities, bathrooms, janitorial supplies, phones, phone receptionists, non-profit status, insurance, etc. with CCFS. As a result, 99 cents of every dollar donated to CCFS is spent purchasing food!*

*CCFS is a member agency of Second Harvest Heartland; a member of "Feeding America", a national network of over 200 food banks serving every state in America. Membership means access to millions of pounds of surplus food and grocery donations from manufacturers and producers throughout the country. As a result, \$9.00 in food is distributed for every \$1.00 donated.*

*CCFS also receives donations from local sources such as churches, schools, youth and service organizations, public service organizations, businesses, and families.*
