## The first Life Care Center

opened its doors at the University of Minnesota campus. Shortly thereafter, additional Life Care Centers were opened in Minnesota and Wisconsin. There are now 20 Centers in Minnesota and 2 in Eastern Wisconsin.

We are a non-profit agency which relies on the community for funding and merchandise to assist mothers and babies.

Services include a Parenting Group that uses videos, reading materials and real-life testimonials to teach women the fundamentals of raising a newborn. The Learn and Earn Education Group rewards clients' with redeemable credits for participating in discussions and completing educational readings and instructional videos on numerous parenting topics .

WLCC is staffed by volunteers, which makes them the heart and soul of the organization.



A weekly, instructor-led educational Parenting Group offers new parents skills in baby-rearing, pre-natal care, safety, parenting and balancing work and family responsibilities.

St. Genevieve's participates in the WLCC Baby Bottle fundraiser each fall. Baby bottles are delivered

to the church where they are distributed.

Family's place their loose change in the bottles over several weeks time and then return them to St.

Genevieve's where a volunteer collects and delivers them.
